

# JUNIOR FALL INVITATIONAL SEPTEMBER 25<sup>TH</sup> TO 26<sup>TH</sup>, 2010

## NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, Long Beach, CA

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The timing sequence of rule 26 will be changed. The changes will appear in the Sailing Instructions.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to all boats of the Naples Sabot class skippered by Juniors who are members' "in good standing" of an SCYA affiliated yacht club, to members of US SAILING Association-affiliated yacht clubs if they reside outside the SCYA area, and to foreign sailors who are members of their respective National Governing Authorities.
- 2.2. RELATED EVENTS: This regatta is the first of the Southern California Youth Yacht Racing Association (SCYYRA) 2010-2011 North Series. A separate entry for the North Series is required for A-fleet sailors wishing to be scored in the Series.

  - b) The 24th Annual Yacht Clubs of Long Beach Charity Regatta Benefiting The Children's Clinic will be sailed in conjunction with this regatta on Sunday, September 26; all entrants in this regatta will be automatically entered in the Charity Regatta with no additional entry fee.

### 3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. Seven (7) races are scheduled, with no more than four (4) races to be sailed on any one day.
- 3.2. The Warning Signal for the first race each day will be at 1155.

### 4. ENTRIES AND FEES

Five (5) **PAID** entries are required to establish a class. Classes may be started together but scored separately. Entry fees are as follows:

Eligible boats may enter online or in person. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED VIA MAIL OR FAX.** Online entries will be accepted until 1600 on the Friday immediately preceding the regatta; thereafter entries may only be made in person. In-person entries will be accepted until 1030 on regatta morning.

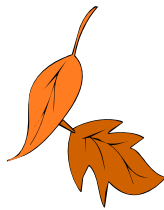

### 5. COMPETITORS' MEETINGS

Competitors' meetings will be held on the ABYC patio on Saturday at 1030. A separate competitors' meeting for the Charity Regatta will be held on the ABYC patio on Sunday at 1030.

### 6. SUPPORT BOATS

All support boats, including coach and spectator boats, must check in at registration prior to the competitors' briefing and shall meet with a race official immediately following the competitors' meeting.

### 7. SCORING

- 7.1. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.2. One (1) race constitutes a series.

### 8. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to the following schedule:

Five (5) boats	One (1) trophy;
Six (6) to eight (8)	Two (2) trophies;
Nine (9) to 11	Three (3) trophies;
12 to 14	Four (4) trophies;
15 or more	Five (5) trophies.

### 9. ARBITRATION

All protests involving rules of Part 2 will first be submitted to arbitration. The arbitration procedure will be posted on the Official Regatta Notice Board as an addendum to the Sailing Instructions.

### 10. LAUNCHING

Two hoists (maximum capacity 5,000 lbs.) and a dinghy ramp are available. Every boat using a hoist must have its own INTERNAL sling.

### 11. PARKING AND STORAGE

Due to space limitations, parking on ABYC grounds is restricted. Off-street parking is available across the street in municipal lots. Participants should obtain parking passes from the ABYC office. Participants may bring their boats into the ABYC yard on Friday between 0900 and 1700. Extended storage on a space-available basis may be requested IN ADVANCE by contacting the ABYC office. NOTE: ABYC is closed on Monday and Tuesday except for card-key access to the grounds.

### 12. HOSPITALITY

- The hospitality of ABYC is extended to all participants.
- The Galley will be open each day.
- All participants and guests are invited to the Charity Regatta Burger Bash at ABYC on Sunday after racing and to participate in the silent auction occurring throughout the day on Sunday. ### 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

### 14. SAFETY

ABYC recommends that all competitors wear personal flotation devices while on the water. The Y flag (personal flotation required) will be flown at all regattas from October 15 through April 14, and it may be flown at other regattas.
