



LIDO 14 TWILIGHT'S

APRIL 7TH TO SEPTEMBER 29TH, 2010

NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, Long Beach, CA and Lido 14 Class Association Fleet Six.

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The timing sequence of rule 26 will be changed. The changes will appear in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3. The 720 rule is amended to 360 degree turn for penalties.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This series is open to members "in good standing" of Alamitos Bay Yacht Club (ABYC), who are members of Lido 14 Fleet 6, and the Lido 14 Class Association and invited guests.
- 2.2. This series is open to boats of the Lido 14 class that comply with the measurement rules as defined by the Lido 14 Association by-laws.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. The Series will comprise three (3) races held every Wednesday evening from April 7, 2010 until September 29, 2010.
- 3.2. Three races are scheduled each evening but may vary according to conditions.
- 3.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal for each day is 1755 in April and September and 1825 for other months.

4. ENTRIES AND FEES

- 4.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the ABYC Entry Form and paying \$10 per month per boat beginning in May.
- 4.2. Eligible boats may enter in person. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED VIA MAIL OR FAX.

5. SCORING

- 5.1. The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A of the racing rules will be used, except as follows:
 - a) In Appendix A, series and race scores shall apply to the competitor helming the boat, not the boat. This changes rule A2, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, A8, A9, A10.
 - b) Rule A9 (RACE SCORES IN A SERIES LONGER THAN A REGATTA) shall apply, except that, a competitor that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place two more than the number of competitors that came to the starting area. This changes rule A9.
 - c) A competitor's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes rule A2.
 - d) A competitor who launches their boat shall be deemed to have come to the starting area for all races that evening.
- 5.2. The different divisions; Lido 14 A and Lido 14 B, Lido 14 Women, and Lido 14 Junior, shall sail together as one fleet. The ranking for the different categories will be extracted from the overall position in the combined fleet without re-calculations (the points remain the same).

- 5.3. For the Monthly Series and Overall Series only, Any any competitor attending a Lido 14 Regatta elsewhere or acting as PRO will be awarded the average of its other races in accordance with rule A10(a), in the Monthly Series and Overall Series, except that races in which the competitor did not compete shall not be included in the average.
- 5.4. The Overall Series shall be the total of a competitor's race scores.
- 5.5. The Monthly Series shall be the total of a competitor's race scores for the month.
- 5.6. The Fleet Representative Series to determine the 2011 Club Champion Representative shall be the total of a competitor's race scores from the last Wednesday of each month from May through August.

6. PRIZES

- 6.1. Prizes will be awarded depending on the fleet finances.
- 6.2. There are no perpetual trophies awarded for this series.

7. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

8. SAFETY

ABYC recommends that all competitors wear personal flotation devices while on the water. The Y flag (personal flotation required) will be flown at all regattas from October 15 through April 14, and it may be flown at other regattas.
