NAPLES SABOT TWILIGHT'S

MAY 6TH TO AUGUST 26TH, 2010

NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, Long Beach, CA

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The timing sequence of rule 26 will be changed. The changes will appear in the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to members "in good standing" of Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, who are also members "in good standing" of Alamitos Bay Naples Sabot Fleet, and the Naples Sabot Class Association.
- 2.2. This regatta is open to boats of the Naples Sabot class that comply with the measurement rules as defined by the Naples Sabot Association by-laws.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. The Series will comprise two (2) races held every Thursday evening from May 6, 2010 until August 26, 2010.
- 3.2. A boat must compete on three evenings, six (6) races, to qualify for the monthly series.
- 3.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal for each day is 1755.

4. ENTRIES AND FEES

Eligible boats may enter by completing the ABYC Entry Form and paying the appropriate fees. Fees may be paid in one of three ways as follows:

	ABYC Member
Entire Series (May – August)	\$30
Each Month	\$10
Each Night	\$2

Eligible boats may enter in person.

5. SCORING

- 5.1. The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A of the racing rules will be used, except as follows:
 - a) In Appendix A, series and race scores shall apply to the competitor helming the boat, not the boat. This changes rule A2, A9.
 - b) A competitor's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes rule A2.
 - c) Rule A9 (RACE SCORES IN A SERIES LONGER THAN A REGATTA) shall apply.
 - d) A competitor who launches their boat shall be deemed to have come to the starting area for all races that evening.

5.2. Any competitor attending a Naples Sabot Regatta elsewhere or acting as PRO will be awarded the average of its other races in accordance with rule A10(a), in the Monthly Series and Overall Series.

5.3. The Overall Series shall be the total of a competitor's race scores.

5.4. The Monthly Series shall be the total of a competitor's race scores for the month.

6. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to the following schedule:

Up to Five (5) boats	One (1) trophy;
Six (6) to eight (8)	Two (2) trophies;
Nine (9) to 11	Three (3) trophies;
12 to 14	Four (4) trophies;
15 or more	Five (5) trophies.

There are NO perpetual trophies awarded at this regatta.

7. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

8. SAFETY

ABYC recommends that all competitors wear personal flotation devices while on the water. The Y flag (personal flotation required) will be flown at all regattas from October 15 through April 14, and it may be flown at other regattas.
