



## CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP REGATTA

MAY 5<sup>TH</sup>, 2012

### NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority will be the Alamitos Bay Yacht Club, Long Beach, CA.

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The timing sequence of rule 26 will be changed. The changes will appear in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to representatives of each "racing fleet" of ABYC. A "racing fleet" is defined as a fleet that actively participates in ABYC's annual duty-fleet obligations, which includes participating as a duty fleet hosting a regatta and hosting an ABYC general membership meeting and program. The ABYC Fleet Captain shall have final approval of a fleet's status as a "racing fleet."
- 2.2. This regatta is intended as a competition among the current fleet champions of each ABYC racing fleet; however, the Fleet Captain of each fleet may name two representatives of their fleet to compete. All competitors must be members in good standing of ABYC and of the fleet they are representing. The ABYC Fleet Captain shall have final approval of competitors to insure conformance with this rule.
- 2.3. The regatta will be sailed in Lido 14s provided by the ABYC Lido 14 fleet. Boats will be assigned by draw and rotated between races. Combined weight of the skipper and crew shall be 300 pounds minimum in accordance with Lido 14 class rules; additional weight to achieve this minimum, if required, must be brought by the competitors and will be moved from boat to boat.

#### 3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1. Three (3) races are scheduled.
- 3.2. The Warning Signal for the first race will be at 1057.

#### 4. ENTRIES AND FEES

- 4.1. . Not less than twenty-one (21) days in advance of the regatta, the ABYC Fleet Captain will e-mail invitations to the Fleet Captains of each racing fleet. The e-mail will include either an attached copy of the Notice of Race or a link to the ABYC website where the Notice of Race may be viewed (or both).
- 4.2. Each team will be required to complete an ABYC Entry Application on the day of the regatta.
- 4.3. There is no Entry Fee

#### 5. COMPETITORS' MEETINGS

- 5.1. Competitors' meetings will be held on the ABYC patio at 1000.

#### 6. SCORING

- 6.1. One (1) race constitutes a series.

#### 7. TROPHIES

- 7.1. The Kim Thompson Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winning crew.

#### 8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 8.1. Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

#### 9. SAFETY

- 9.1. ABYC recommends that all competitors wear personal flotation devices while on the water.
