Four Easy Steps to Membership

1. Download an application from this website or contact Membership Chair Jim Grubbs by phone at (562) 439-4911 or by e-mail at jamesbgrubbs@msn.com
2. Submit a completed Membership Application form that includes the names of five (5) member sponsors with a \$50 processing fee. The initial sponsors will assist with developing additional contacts to complete the list of five (5). Let the membership chair know if there is a problem and they will ensure you meet other members. Another option is to attend a General Membership Meeting held on the 3rd Friday of each month. Interested parties are always welcome! 3. The Membership Chair will send prepared questionnaires to the five (5) members named on the application.
4. When all questionnaires are returned and the approved by the Board, the member's name will be posted for thirty (30) days.
5. After thirty (30) days the new member will be introduced and presented with a club burgee at the next General Membership Meeting.

² Junior members have all the rights and privileges accorded to Regular Members except they may not vote, hold office, or extend club privileges to guests.

³ You must be a Regular member to become an Associate Non-Resident Member, Non-Resident Member. Dues for these classifications are paid annually.

⁴ You must be a Regular member to become an Anchor Member. Anchor members have all the rights and privileges accorded to Regular Members except they may not vote, or hold office.
