NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of US Sailing will apply: Appendix V, rule V1, Penalties at time of incident. The sailing instructions may also change other rules. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the classes listed below. Additional classes will be accepted based on the number of entries and the classes that are established.
 - a) Ocean one-design classes include: A-Cat, Cal 20, CFJ, C-15, Etchells, F-18, Finn, 5-0-5, Laser Standard, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Open Skiff-Ocean, Optimist, Portsmouth, RS Tera-Ocean, Shields, Snipe, Tempest, Thistle, 29er, and Viper 640.
 - b) Bay Course classes include: Lido 14, Naples Sabot Junior, Naples Sabot Senior, Open Skiff-Bay, Optimist Green, and RS Tera-Bay
- 2.2 Yacht club membership is not required for this regatta.
- 2.3 Sailors of eligible boats may enter by registering on-line at regattanetwork.com, completing an entry form and mailing, or delivering it in person to ABYC.
- 2.4 Online and mail-in entries will be accepted until 1600 on the Friday immediately preceding the regatta. Thereafter entries may only be made in person. In-person entries for ocean one-design classes will be accepted until 0930 and bay class will be accepted until 1000 on regatta morning.
- 2.5 Five paid entries are required to establish a class. Classes may be started together but scored separately. Boats that do not establish a class may be placed in Portsmouth.
- 2.6 Related Events a) **This is the Lido 14 Fleet 6 Championship.**
- 2.7 Participants are encouraged to participate in the CREW CHALLENGE (see page 6 of NOR)

3.0 REGATTA ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 See the Regatta Entry Form for regatta entry fees. All fees are donations to The Children's Clinic, non-profit Tax ID 95-1643332. Please make checks payable to The Children's Clinic.
- 3.2 The regatta fee includes launching, recovery and storage for visiting competing boats from the day prior to the event until the day following the event.
- 3.3 Boats visiting ABYC may request extended storage IN ADVANCE by contacting the ABYC office. The price is \$10 per day.
- 3.4. Any boat or trailer found on ABYC property without prior written authorization from ABYC is subject to impound and associated fees.

4.0 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 Bay Classes. FIVE races are scheduled.
- 4.2 Ocean Classes FOUR races are scheduled.
- 4.3 The Warning for the first race will be at 1157.

5.0 COMPETITORS MEETINGS

Competitors meetings for Ocean One Design classes will be held on the ABYC patio at 1000, Bay classes will be held on the ABYC patio at 1030.

6.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Will be available at each venue.

7.0 VENUE

Bay class races will be held in Alamitos Bay. Ocean one-design classes will be held in Long Beach Harbor inside the Federal Breakwater.

8.0 SCORING

- 8.1 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.2 One (1) race constitutes a series.

9.0 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes shall be awarded to the following schedule:

Five (5) boats	One trophy
Six (6) boats to Eight (8) boats	Two trophies
Nine (9) to Eleven (11)	Three trophies
Twelve (12) to Fourteen (14)	Four trophies
Fifteen or more (15 or more)	Five trophies

- 9.3 The highest placed member of Lido 14 Fleet 6 in the Lido A class will be named Lido 14 Fleet 6 Champion.

10.0 LAUNCHING

Two hoists (maximum 5000 pounds) and a dinghy ramp are available. Every boat using the hoist shall have its own internal sling.

11.0 PARKING AND STORAGE

- 11.1 Free parking may be available on the street; please do not park in front of driveways. Metered parking is \$1 per hour, payable by cash or credit card.
- 11.3 Visiting competing boats may request extended storage IN ADVANCE by contacting the ABYC office. The cost is \$10.00 per day paid in advance.
- 11.4 Any boat or trailer found on ABYC property without prior written authorization from ABYC is subject to impound and associated fees.

12.0 PROTEST FILING

A boat intending to file a protest must notify the Race Committee promptly after finishing a race. All protest hearings will be held at ABYC. All protests will be written on forms provided by ABYC and must be submitted to the ABYC office within 60 minutes after the host Committee Boat docks.

13.0 COACH/SUPPORT BOATS

- 13.1 Coach/Support Boats are allowed for this regatta. The skipper of each Coach/Support boat must register with the organizing authority and pay the refundable fee of \$5.
- 13.2 Coach/Support Boats must be prepared to render assistance to a boat in need and perform any other function requested by the Race Committee.
- 13.3 Unless otherwise directed by the Race Committee no coach/support boat may be within 100 yards of the course boundaries, for all classes, nor have any communication with a competitor between the warning signal and the time that the race is abandoned or the competitor has finished.
- 13.4 All coach/support boats must be equipped with a VHF radio and be prepared to monitor a designated VHF channel.

14.0 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15.0 FOOD AND BEVERAGES

The ABYC Galley will be open from 0830 to 1500, with breakfast and lunch selections, soft drinks, wine, and beer for reasonable fees.

16.0 REGATTA SWAG AND SILENT AUCTION. ALL PROCEEDS GO TO THE CHILDREN'S CLINIC

Founded in 1939 by local physicians and community leaders, The Children's Clinic, "Serving Children & Their Families", is an independent 501(c)(3) licensed, Federally Qualified Community Health Center, with 11 sites and two mobile medical clinics. TCC is dedicated to providing comprehensive high quality health care to medically underserved, low income, and high-risk populations of all ages. Four of its clinics are in Long Beach Unified School District sites, making access to comprehensive services easier for students and families.

During the 2017-2018 fiscal year TCC served of 40,000 patients, with 125,000 medical and behavioral health visits. Its staff made 55,000 social service and education visits, and served 1,300 homeless patients through approximately 6,000 encounters. It partners with the Long Beach Unified School District; Khmer Girls in Action (teen wellness). The mobile health units provided 2,400 visits to homeless and other patients directly where they live. TCC also is in partnership with the Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles, and Mental Health America. TCC knows that living in a safe and nurturing environment supports lifelong health and well-being.

TCC now has four new programs to reach children as early as possible to identify trauma and toxic stress. It provides needed services and support while building skills, resiliency, and protective factors for the child and family. These programs include Every Child Bright Beginnings Initiative; First 5 LA's Project DULCE; and Healthy Families America home visitation programs, as well as its new school-site health clinic at Roosevelt Elementary School.

On the horizon, TCC is in the process of planning to open a site in partnership with Dignity Health St. Mary Medical Center which will be dedicated to the care of low-income seniors in the community.
